Spanish 3 CP

10 Credits

Grade Level: 10-12

Prerequisite: Grade of "C" or better in Spanish 2 or instructor approval.

Meets HS graduation requirement, CSU/UC "E" requirement for language other than English.

This one-year course designed for students who wish to learn to speak and understand Spanish with a greater degree of fluency and accuracy. The primary emphasis of this course is the extension of oral communication, as well as the honing of reading and writing skills. The course includes class discussions, interviews, and compositions about a variety of personal, literature-based, and current events topics. Grammatical principles previously introduced are expanded, and additional ones are presented as student's progress. Emphasis is also placed on developing and expanding vocabulary in all language skills: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. **THIS IS A SPANISH ONLY CLASSROOM OR IMMERSION.**

Homework: Minimum of 2 hours per week of language practice. Extra time will be needed to study for tests, write essays, and work on projects.

Textbooks: Exprésate 3 (for Spanish 3), y Cuaderno de Vocabulario y Gramática 3 (for Spanish 3, received from teacher or copies will be provided of pages used).

Class materials: Please have ready pen, pencil, lined paper, folder, Any English Spanish dictionary (optional purchase on your own or access online for free). Students will be exposed to printed blogs in Spanish, film clips, computers at North Natomas Library, and Youtube karaoke singing pieces in Spanish.

Class Rules: There is no FOOD in class. Students may drink water if they have their own water bottle with them. Restroom break are to take place only after the first 15 minutes after the bell has rung and 15 minutes before the end of class bell rings. Students ARE not to speak disruptively during instruction as this will take from their Class Participation points. Students will be seated according to assigned seating charts created by teacher. If student behavior interrupts learning, students will be required to switch seats to avoid further disruptive behavior. If students are continuously disruptive, referrals to the principal will be made until such behavior is eliminated.
